# STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors.

## Attended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation. Our professional fees include:

- Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements and offering you the choice of meeting in branch, your own home or arr online/by phone, with follow-up meetings as required
- Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (within a 30 mile radius) into our care at John Beattie & Sons, Weensland Road, Hawick, TD9 9NW, every day of the year with no additional charge for out of hours
- Care of the deceased person including dressing before the funeral at John Beattie & Sons, Weensland Road or a branch of your choice
- Providing a suitable coffin real wood veneer with alternative options also available
- Unlimited family viewing with out-of-hours by arrangement By law a fee is listed but we do not charge for viewing
- At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium in our Mercedes E Class hearse or other appropriate vehicle (within a 30 mile radius)

### Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may independently choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself. Unattended funerals must be paid in full prior to the funeral date.

- Burial (funeral director fees only)
- Cremation (funeral director fees and the cremation fee at Borders Crematorium)

### Fees You Must Pay

- For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee (or interment fee charged for digging and closing a new grave or reopening an existing grave). In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is £877.
- For a new grave you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place you may need to pay a removal and remova fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.
- For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is £1,085.
- In England you will usually need to pay doctor's fees as well: two doctors are required to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
- We can help with any specific religious, belief-based and/or cultural requirements you may have.

# TERMS OF BUSINESS

#### Deposits

All third-party costs must be paid within 2 working days of the confirmation of arrangements. In addition, where more than two limousines are required, the cost for the third and subsequent limousines must also be paid in advance as above. Any coffin supplied where the cost exceeds £1,000 will need to be paid in advance. Where a solicitor is accepting responsibility for the invoice in its entirety, the need for a deposit can be waived on receipt of written confirmation of their accepting responsibility for the invoice within 2 working days. Non-payment of the deposit will mean all arrangements are cancelled and termination terms will apply. Where a fully paid funeral pre-payment plan is in place, no deposit is required. Where a 'direct no-service' cremation is instructed payment of the invoice in full is required before the service will proceed. Repatriation of deceased will be pre-paid at the Directors' discretion.

#### Payment

The funeral invoice will normally be sent 7-10 days after the funeral and is due within 30 days of invoice date unless otherwise agreed by us in writing. Monthly payment plans can be agreed where necessary on a case-by-case basis at the company's discretion.

#### Interest

If the invoice remains unpaid beyond the due date, we reserve the right to charge interest on the overdue amount at the rate of 2% per annum above the base lending rate of The Bank of England. The interest shall accrue on a daily basis from the due date until the date of actual payment of the overdue amount. We reserve the right to recover legal and debt collection fees should you breach these terms of payment.
